There are a few items I want to bring to your attention as we head into March.

There are many upcoming opportunities for service, community and also for growing our prayer lives. The Knights will lead the First Sunday Rosary (Sunday, 3/2), Stations of the Cross (Friday, 3/21), and prayer outside of a local abortion clinic (each Saturday beginning 3/8). There is also our monthly Pancake Breakfast on 3/9 and annual Lenten Fish Fry on Friday, 3/14. Be sure to take advantage of these opportunities for prayer, service and fraternity!



March 21, 2025, the Knights will host the Stations. This will require us to read the reflections as we stop at each Station, leading participants around the church. Please make time to join your fellow Knights in this immensely spiritual and powerful event which draws us into the Passion of Christ during Lent .

Right to Life

We are going to try something new for our Right to Life program. We know that The Supreme Court ruling, Roe v. Wade has been overturned and that abortion can only happen in states that allow it. I looked at Southern and Midwestern states around us come up with many ways to eliminate abortion or at least severely restrict it. Florida and S. C. even have a heartbeat law that says that you cannot abort if there is a heartbeat. One state even had no surgical abortions last year (Indiana). Our laws are so liberal that we are the mecca for abortions in the South. Waiting for a political solution is apparently not the answer for us. So we have joined a group of people who will pray at the local abortion clinic every Saturday during Lent. Please bring your rosary. We are meeting from 9-11 only on the first six Saturdays of Lent starting March 8. We will park at Midori Japanese restaurant next to the Women's Choice abortion clinic at **2421 S. Randleman Rd.** near the old K-Mart and stay in that parking lot. The meeting is non-confrontational. It is for prayer, the only real source of power we need. Pregnancy Network will be there with a sonogram machine, that was bought by our Knights, and a nurse to run it and show mothers who want to see their baby what he looks like. Please join us for as many Saturdays as you can. I'll be there for them all. If you want to sit please bring your own chair, rolling or not. The event is in the St. Pius X bulletin for the whole parish to do this with us. Please prayerfully consider this. It is called 40 Days for Life and has been around for years saving many lives, both mother and child.

Pick-up and Drop Off

Our newest hunger program is getting a number of our Knights interested. It involves going to a Greensboro Harris Teeter and picking up food they have ready for us. You go on a day of your choosing and bring it to the Backpack Beginnings warehouse on Alliance Dr, 2 blocks from Motor Mile on Wendover. They have a large warehouse set up like a grocery store where qualified families can shop for free. They have to be a resident of Guilford County, have children 18 and under and be in need of food. This is the same Backpack Beginnings that we have been delivering lunches for the past three years to schools in Greensboro. Several Knights have already started and more are needed.
